



Gateway Academy Auditions 2018/19 Acting C and Musical Theatre C

New students are required to audition for our year-long Musical Theatre C (MTC) and Acting C (ACTC) classes:

- Sunday August 26, 2018, 10:30am-1:30pm OR
- Wednesday September 5, 2018, 5:30-8:30pm (MTC)
- Thursday September 6, 2018, 5:30-8:30pm (ACTC)

Audition Requirements

Musical Theatre C (MTC)

Preparation

- Song: The applicant is required to prepare and sing a verse and chorus of a song from a stage musical or a pop song. Please bring sheet music in the desired key for the accompanist: photo-copied, double-sided in a binder.
- Submit on the day: A brief history outline indicating applicant's arts training and performance history

What to expect:

- Auditions are held in a group setting, much as if applicants are taking a class together. Skills in dance, singing and acting will all be covered during the three hours.
- The group will be led in a physical warm up and learn a phrase of choreography.
- The group will be led in a vocal warm up
- The group will also engage in acting exercises that draw out their ensemble skills, comfort with character and text work.

Where: Studios A / B, Gateway Theatre

What to wear:

- All applicants must wear clothing appropriate for moving comfortably and freely
- Applicants with long hair are required to tie it back

Other requirements:

- All applicants are required to bring
 - A brief history outline indicating applicant's arts training and performance history
 - A photo of themselves
- Students must remove all jewelry
- Cell phones must be left outside the room

Acting C (ACTC)

Preparation:

- Monologue: Applicants are required to prepare and present a monologue (2 minutes max), preferably of a character near the applicant's age or a level of social comfort. No script in hand. Monologues will be presented to the group.
- Submit on the day: A brief history outline indicating applicant's arts training and performance history

What to expect:

- Auditions are held in a group setting, much as if applicants are taking a class together.
- The group will be led in physical and vocal warm ups
- The group will also engage in acting exercises that draw out their ensemble skills. Skills in acting, character and text will be explored.
- The group will present their monologues to each other

Where: Studios A / B, Gateway Theatre

What to wear:

- All applicants must wear clothing appropriate for moving comfortably and freely
- Applicants with long hair are required to tie it back

Other requirements:

- All applicants are required to bring
 - A brief history outline indicating applicant's arts training and performance history
 - A photo of themselves
- Students must remove all jewelry
- Cell phones must be left outside the room
