To achieve our organizational mission and connect with the changing population of Richmond, we employ staff with eclectic and multifaceted expertise. As a group we take risks, we empower, we go beyond, and we listen. We embrace difference as something that challenges our understanding and provokes our growth.

Gateway Theatre is looking for a Child Supervisor for our upcoming production of Lionel Bart's *Oliver!*. Present at rehearsals and performances to make sure the safety of the youth performers is upheld, they are a key member of the team in regards to performer support.

Responsibilities will include:

- Arriving at the theatre 15 minutes before performer call time to receive youth performers from their parent/guardian.
- Ensuring the health and safety of all youth performers.
- Ensuring no youth performer is alone with an adult.
- Standing by in the rehearsal room or in the wings while youth performers are onstage and receiving them from the stage as they exit.
- Handing off all youth performers to their parent/guardian at the end of the shift.

Basic Schedule:

- Rehearsals run November 7 – December 1. Youth may be called for rehearsal Wednesday to Friday 4pm-9pm and Saturdays and Sundays 10am-6pm.
- Tech rehearsals run December 3 -December 14. Youth may be called from approximately 3:45pm-10:15pm.
- Performances run Thursday December 14 – Saturday December 31. Show calls will be approximately four hours in length for every show.

Requirements:

- Must be 19+

- Experience working with children
- Ability to work evenings, weekends, and through the holiday break
- Understanding of the theatre and performance demands an asset but not required

- Must be legally able to work in Canada (Canadian citizenship, permanent residency, or existing open work permit).
